6 For an Act entitled: "An Act creating the Trading Bay State Game Refuge."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 16.20 is amended by adding new sections to read:

9 Sec. 16.20.034. TRADING BAY STATE GAME REFUGE. (a) The following
10 state-owned land, including tide and submerged land, and all land,
11 including tide and submerged land, acquired in the future by the state
12 lying within the parcels described in this subsection is established as
13 the Trading Bay State Game Refuge:

14 (1) Township 9 North, Range 13 West, Seward Meridian
15 Sections 5 - 7

16 (2) Township 9 North, Range 14 West, Seward Meridian
17 Sections 1 - 4, E1/2 5, 8 - 17, E 1/2 19, 20 - 24, 26 - 30, E1/2 32, 33,
18 34

19 (3) Township 9 North, Range 15 West, Seward Meridian
20 Sections W1/2 1, 2 - 4, 9 - 11, W1/2 12 and 13, 14 - 16, 19 - 23, W1/2
21 24, 26 - 28, 31 - 35

22 (4) Township 10 North, Range 13 West, Seward Meridian
23 Sections 1 - 12, 14 - 22, 28 - 32

24 (5) Township 10 North, Range 14 West, Seward Meridian
25 Sections 1 - 18, E1/2 19, 20 - 29, 32 - 36

26 (6) Township 10 North, Range 15 West, Seward Meridian
27 Sections 1 - 12, 14 - 23, 26 - 35

28 (7) Township 11 North, Range 13 West, Seward Meridian
29 Sections SW1/4 3, 4 - 10, SW1/4 11, 14 - 36

1 (8) Township 11 North, Range 14 - 15 West, Seward Meridian

3 (9) Township 12 North, Range 13 West, Seward Meridian

5 (10) Township 12 North, Range 14 West, Seward Meridian
6 Sections 23 - 26, 27, 31 - 33, 36

7 (b) The state may not acquire by eminent domain privately owned
8 land within land specified in (a) of this section for inclusion in the
9 Trading Bay State Game Refuge. The Department of Natural Resources may
10 adopt, in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62),
11 zoning regulations governing privately owned land within the Trading Bay
12 State Game Refuge.

13 (c) Egress and ingress to and from private property within the
14 parcels described in (a) of this section shall be allowed through access
15 corridors established through agreement between the Department of
16 Natural Resources, the Department of Fish and Game, and the private
17 property owners involved.
