For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to liquor licenses."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 04.10.020 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(o) grocery retail license.

10

* Sec. 2. AS 04.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 04.10.105. GROCERY RETAIL LICENSE. The holder of a grocery

12

retail license may sell in his establishment beer and wine in bottles

13

and original packages not to be consumed on the premises where sold.

14

This license may be issued only to grocery stores where sale of food for

15

human consumption off the premises is the principal business conducted.

16

This license may not be issued to a grocery store located in a community

17

in which no premises licensed under sec. 20 of this chapter are operated

18

or in which a community liquor license has been issued under sec. 139 of

19

this chapter, or in a community with a population less than 3,500 to a

20

grocery store within two miles of an operating retail store licensed

21

under sec. 100 of this chapter. Population limitations in this chapter

22

on issuance of licenses do not apply to licenses issued under this

23

section. The provisions of sec. 430 of this chapter which apply to

24

retail licenses apply to licenses under this section. The grocery

25

retail license fee is \$500.
