6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to planning grants for areawide
7 health planning and development activities; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 18.07 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 ARTICLE 2. HEALTH SYSTEMS

12 AGENCIES.

13 Sec. 18.07.110. PLANNING GRANTS TO HEALTH SYSTEM AGENCIES.

14 (a) The Department of Health and Social Services shall award grants
15 in accordance with this section, to health systems agencies established
16 in Alaska under PL 93-641. A health systems agency established under
17 PL 93-641 is entitled to a grant of \$100,000 during its first year
18 as such an agency; \$75,000 during its second year; \$50,000 during
19 its third year; and \$25,000 during its fourth year; it is not entitled
20 to such a grant during its fifth and succeeding years.

21 (b) In addition to a grant under (a) of this section, a health
22 systems agency established in Alaska under PL 93-641 is entitled
23 to a grant in an amount equal to the contributions provided to that
24 agency by local sources, as allowable under PL 93-641, but not exceed-
25 ing: \$25,000 during its first year as such an agency; \$50,000 during
26 its second year; \$75,000 during its third year; and \$100,000 during
27 each succeeding year.

28 (c) The department shall establish by regulation a method,
29 consistent with state accounting procedures, for determining the

1 monetary value of contributions made in kind by local sources to
2 health systems agencies.
