6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the relationship between the
7 borough school district and the borough; and providing
8 for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 29.33.050 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 29.33.050. EDUCATION. (a) Each borough constitutes a
12 borough school district and establishes, maintains, and operates a
13 system of public schools on an areawide basis as provided in AS 14.14.-
14 060. Notwithstanding the provisions of AS 29.48.310 - 29.48.330, the
15 borough assembly has only those powers with respect to education or to
16 borough school boards that are granted by statute.

17 (b) A military reservation within an organized borough is not part
18 of the borough school district until the military mission is terminated
19 or until inclusion in the borough school district is approved by the
20 Department of Education. However, operation of the military reservation
21 schools by the borough school district may be required by the Department
22 of Education under AS 14.14.110. If the military mission of a military
23 reservation terminates or continued management and control by the state-
24 operated schools is disapproved by the Department of Education, opera-
25 tion, management and control of schools on military reservations trans-
26 fers to the borough school district in which the military reservation is
27 located.

28 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
29 070(c).
