6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to exemption from local taxation of
7 property used for religious purposes; and providing for
8 an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 29.53.020(b) is amended to read:

11 (b) "Property used exclusively for religious purposes" includes
12 but is not limited to the following property owned by a religious organi-
13 zation:

14 (1) the residence of a bishop, [THE] pastor, priest, rabbi,
15 minister or member of a religious order of a recognized religious
16 organization;

17 (2) a structure, its furniture and its fixtures used solely,
18 or in conjunction with other exempt purposes, for public worship, chari-
19 table purposes, religious administrative offices, religious education
20 or a nonprofit hospital;

21 (3) lots supporting and adjacent to a structure or residence
22 mentioned in (1) or (2) of this subsection which are necessary to con-
23 venient use;

24 (4) lots required by local ordinance for parking near a
25 structure defined in (2) of this subsection.

26 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1976.
