6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to uniform traffic laws."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 28.01.010(b) and (c) are amended to read:

9 (b) A municipality may adopt by reference all or a part of this
10 title and regulations promulgated under this title, and may request and
11 shall receive from the Departments of Public Safety and Community and
12 Regional Affairs assistance in the drafting of model ordinances for
13 adoption by reference. Notwithstanding (a) of this section, a munici-
14 pality may enact necessary ordinances to meet specific local require-
15 ments.

16 (c) A copy of all traffic ordinances enacted by a municipality
17 shall be forwarded to the commissioner of public safety, and specific
18 notice of any inconsistent ordinances shall be given by the municipality
19 when the copy of the ordinances is forwarded. So far as practicable,
20 the section number identifying a particular municipal traffic ordinance
21 shall be the same as the section number identifying a corresponding pro-
22 vision of this title or regulations promulgated under this title.

23 * Sec. 2. AS 28.01.010 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

24 (f) Regulations promulgated pertaining to a matter partially or
25 wholly governed by this title shall be mutually consistent and compa-
26 tible, and shall complement each other, as far as practicable. For the
27 purpose of uniformity, the Department of Public Safety shall offer and
28 receive reasonable assistance in the coordination and promulgation of
29 these regulations.

1 (g) The provisions of this title and the regulations promulgated
2 under this title shall, as far as practicable, conform to the recommen-
3 dations of the current edition of the Uniform Vehicle Code adopted by
4 the National Committee on Uniform Traffic Laws and Ordinances.

5 * Sec. 3. AS 28.01 is amended by adding a new section to read:

6 Sec. 28.01.020. SHORT TITLE. This chapter may be cited as the
7 Alaska Uniform Traffic Laws Act.

8 * Sec. 4. AS 29.48.035(a)(1) is amended to read:

9 (1) vehicle, [AND] pedestrian, and other traffic, and licen-
10 sing and operation of motor vehicles, including snow vehicles and off-
11 highway [, OTHER HIGHWAY] vehicles, and operators not inconsistent with
12 AS 28.01.010;
