6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the University of Alaska; and pro-  
7 viding for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.40 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 14.40.119. ESTABLISHMENT OF A COLLEGE IN CERTAIN MUNICIPALITI-  
11 TIES. (a) In a municipality of more than 150,000 population, the uni-  
12 versity shall establish a college offering a four-year instructional  
13 program leading to a baccalaureate degree and courses of study leading  
14 to appropriate graduate degrees. That college shall be administered  
15 separately from a community college located in the same municipality.  
16 However, to ensure a student's ability to transfer from the community  
17 college to a four-year college, the academic calendar, curriculum and  
18 academic credit of the two institutions shall be articulated in the  
19 manner prescribed by the Board of Regents.

20 (b) The chief administrative officer of the college established  
21 under (a) of this section shall be a chancellor who shall be appointed by,  
22 and is responsible to, the Board of Regents.

23 (c) The chancellor of the college shall

24 (1) give general direction to the work of the college in all  
25 departments, subject to the approval of the Board of Regents;

26 (2) appoint and prescribe the qualifications for all college  
27 officers, faculty and staff, whether part or full-time;

28 (3) define the duties and supervise the performance of those  
29 persons whom he appoints to positions established by the Board of Regents;

2 (4) prepare and submit a complete program budget to the  
3 Board of Regents for each department, division, program or other  
4 academic or administrative unit in the college including but not limited  
5 to funds from fees, grants, contracts, agreements, bequests, gifts,  
6 trusts, or endowments.

7 \* Sec. 2. AS 14.40.170(a)(1) and (2) are amended to read:

8 (1) appoint the president of the university and the chancellor  
9 of the college established under sec. 119 of this chapter by a majority  
10 vote of the whole board, and the president and chancellor may attend  
11 meetings of the board;

12 (2) fix the compensation of the president of the university,  
13 chancellor, all heads of departments, professors, teachers, instructors  
14 and other officers;

15 \* Sec. 3. AS 14.40.170(b)(2) is amended to read:

16 (2) determine and regulate the course of instruction in the  
17 university with the advise of the president and chancellor.

18 \* Sec. 4. AS 14.40.240 is amended to read:

19 Sec. 14.40.240. POWER OF PRESIDENT TO SUSPEND AND EXPEL STUDENTS.  
20 The power to suspend and expel a student for misconduct or other cause  
21 and to reinstate him is vested [SOLELY] in the president of the univer-  
22 sity and in the chancellor of a college established under sec. 119 of  
23 this chapter.
