6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the introduction of evidence in a
7 child custody proceeding; and changing Rule 43(b),
8 Rules of Civil Procedure."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 09.25 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 09.25.140. EVIDENCE OF ILLEGITIMACY. In a child custody
12 proceeding concerning a child born in wedlock, evidence that the
13 husband was not the biological father of the child may not be intro-
14 duced unless the action is brought within three years of the date of
15 the birth of the child.

16 * Sec. 2. Section 1 of this Act has the effect of changing Rule 43(b),
17 Rules of Civil Procedure, by limiting the introduction of evidence concerning
18 the issue of legitimacy in a child custody proceeding.
