3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 NINTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to garbage disposal in rural
6 areas of the state.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS there are many rural communities in Alaska that suffer from
9 inadequate garbage disposal facilities; and

10 WHEREAS this is especially true for the great volumes of canned goods,
11 bottled goods and the like that are purchased by those Alaskans living in
12 remote areas of the state; and

13 WHEREAS this situation can, and often does, lend itself to unhealthy and
14 unsanitary conditions; and

15 WHEREAS there are garbage disposal units and methods that could
16 alleviate this problem in the villages, but usually the several communities
17 do not have the resources to take care of the problem;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is
19 respectfully requested to direct the Departments of Health and Social Services
20 and Environmental Conservation to immediately undertake a joint effort to
21 plan and to implement, at the earliest possible time, a system of garbage
22 disposal in all communities of the state that now lack adequate facilities.
