5 Relating to a study of administrative
6 orders.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS in recent years, various governors of the state have accomplished
9 or attempted to accomplish both minor and major changes in the executive
10 branch of government via the issuance of administrative orders; and

11 WHEREAS neither the Constitution of the State of Alaska nor the Alaska
12 Statutes provide for the issuance of administrative orders; and

13 WHEREAS their form and use likewise are not provided for; and

14 WHEREAS it is important that a governor have a vehicle to effect changes
15 which do not require the force of law; and

16 WHEREAS it is likewise important that the vehicle used be defined and
17 its form and use consistent;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Legislative
19 Affairs Agency is directed to conduct a study of administrative orders with
20 the objective of making recommendations, in bill form, and otherwise as to
21 their form and use; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED that the recommendations be presented to the Ninth
23 Legislature - Second Session.
