6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS Elleighfare "Rusty" Rivers, a prominent Alaskan, has recently
8 passed away; and

9 WHEREAS for over 35 years of devoted service with the American Red Cross
10 she helped thousands of families and individuals here and around the world;

12 WHEREAS to all who knew her she exemplified the graciousness of the
13 southern gentlewoman she was, but also always had the stiff upper lip of an
14 Alaskan; and

15 WHEREAS, in addition to her handling of thousands of cases of assistance
16 to military and civilian families, she organized many first aid and water
17 safety courses; and

18 WHEREAS thousands of Alaskans have been benefited through their meeting
19 Elleighfare Rivers;

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it laments the
21 passing of Elleighfare "Rusty" Rivers, but expresses its heartfelt belief
