3 TN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
4 NINTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Honoring Stanley J. McCutcheon.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS Stanley J. McCutcheon, long-time prominent Alaskan, has recently  
8 passed away; and

9 WHEREAS Stanley McCutcheon, continuously through the years, dedicated  
10 his entire adult life to defending and battling for the lives, rights and  
11 well-being of all Alaskans; and

12 WHEREAS, as an eminent trial attorney, he devoted, often without any  
13 monetary remuneration, countless hours to the able defense of Alaskans from  
14 all walks of life; and

15 WHEREAS he served with distinction in the Territorial House of Repre-  
16 sentatives from 1943 - 1955, and as Speaker of the House in 1949, championed  
17 Alaska's first successful battles to free Alaska from the vested absentee  
18 interests which siphoned off Alaska's wealth to the detriment of all Alaskans;  
19 and

20 WHEREAS the late Senator Ernest Gruening described Stanley McCutcheon  
21 as the greatest legislator he ever knew on the local or national level; and

22 WHEREAS, he was an effective and infatigable advocate of statehood for  
23 Alaska and for the rights of Alaska's Native people; and

24 WHEREAS he always utilized his considerable powers of persuasion to help  
25 those in need and to bring out the best qualities of all people;

26 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it conveys its  
27 deeply felt sorrow at the untimely passing of Stanley J. McCutcheon and  
28 reaffirms in his honor its collective dedication to serve all Alaskans with  
29 the same devotion and energy he gave during his lifetime.
