5 Relating to the repair of blacktopping of  
6 the City of Nome - Beltz High School com-  
7 plex road.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the approximately four miles of road between the City of Nome  
10 and the Beltz High School complex is heavily used by residents and students;  
11 and

12 WHEREAS this four-mile stretch of road is a basically sound road, but  
13 the blacktopping has deteriorated to the point that significant hazards are  
14 created; and

15 WHEREAS in addition to the hazards, this deterioration is extremely harm-  
16 ful to vehicles using the road, thus creating an indirect, but very real  
17 cost;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it respectfully re-  
19 quests the Governor to direct the Department of Highways to repair the black-  
20 topping on the road between the City of Nome and the Beltz High School comple  
21 during the 1976 construction season.
