2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 89

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 NINTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the Alaska Plan Policy Board.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS it is a policy of the state that Alaskans shall be given prefer-
8 ence in hiring in projects involving the extraction, transportation, and
9 processing of the state's natural resources; and

10 WHEREAS there are numerous reports that this policy is being violated;
11 and

12 WHEREAS it is of critical importance to the economic, political and
13 social future of the state that this policy be strongly implemented;

14 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature calls upon the Governor
15 to use all the power of state government to enforce this policy; and be it

16 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature calls upon the Alyeska Pipeline
17 Service Company, its contractors and subcontractors, all labor unions, Alaska
18 Native organizations, and the Alaska Plan Policy Board to cooperate fully in
19 carrying out the policy of preferential hire for Alaskans; and be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature calls upon all Alaskans to report
21 known or suspected violations of this policy to the Commissioner of Labor,
22 Box 1149, Juneau, Alaska 99811.

23 COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to all executive branch depart-
24 ments, the Alyeska Pipeline Service Company, the Alaska Plan Policy Board,
25 all labor unions operating in Alaska, and all newspapers, radio and tele-
26 vision stations in the state.
