2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 101

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 NINTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Requesting a study of a uniform accounting  
6 and reporting system for health service  
7 institutions.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the Secretary of the Department of Health, Education and Welfare  
10 has been directed by P.L. 93-641, sec. 1533(d) to establish a uniform system  
11 of accounting and reporting data associated with the operation of health  
12 service institutions, including the calculation of the cost and volume of  
13 services provided by health service institutions in the aggregate and per  
14 individual institution, the calculation of rates to be charged insurers and  
15 other payers to health service institutions, and classification of health  
16 service institutions; and

17 WHEREAS health service institutions in Alaska are both regulated and  
18 reimbursed by the federal government, and it is anticipated that the uniform  
19 system developed by the Secretary will be utilized in future regulation and  
20 reimbursement; and

21 WHEREAS the health service institutions of Alaska contend with problems  
22 peculiar only to this state for which provision should be made in any equi-  
23 table national system of accounting and reporting;

24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it respectfully  
25 requests the Governor to direct the commissioner of administration to under-  
26 take a study of the feasibility of using uniform cost accounting systems in  
27 Alaska, paying particular attention to any cost accounting problems peculiar  
28 to Alaska; and be it

29 FURTHER RESOLVED that the conclusions of the study be communicated to

1 the Secretary of Health, Education and Welfare to aid him in developing the  
2 system mandated by P.L. 93-641 and the Alaska State Legislature.
