5 Commending the contestants in the state
6 small schools championship playoff.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the small schools state championship basketball playoff has
9 recently culminated in a hairsbreath victory by the Nome-Beltz Nanooks over a
10 team from Fort Yukon; and

11 WHEREAS almost the entire population of Fort Yukon turned out to watch
12 the final game of the three-game championship series; and

13 WHEREAS the Nanooks fought their way back into contention after losing
14 by a single point in the second game the night before; and

15 WHEREAS the score in the final game was tied at the end of the first and
16 second quarters of play; and

17 WHEREAS the Nanooks only edged ahead in the third and fourth quarters to
18 win by a final score of 46-40; and

19 WHEREAS the final game was marked by fine play on the part of both
20 teams, especially the Nanooks' defensive effort;

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it congratulates the
22 Nome-Beltz Nanooks on their state small schools championship, and further
23 congratulates the Fort Yukon team, runnerup and champion of Region 2.
