5 Honoring Celia Hunter as the newly-elected  
6 President of the Wilderness Society.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS Celia Hunter has been one of the main driving forces in Alaska  
9 for protection of the environment; and

10 WHEREAS this deep concern resulted in the early formation of the Alaska  
11 Conservation Society, with a rapidly growing membership of those who share  
12 her feelings about the environment; and

13 WHEREAS her respect for the land is also shown by her long-term co-  
14 ownership of Camp Denali, which is maintained as a wilderness camp to intro-  
15 duce persons to the benefits of wilderness and outdoor life and which was  
16 recently cited by the Society of American Travel Writers for excellence; and

17 WHEREAS, in addition, Celia has recently served the state's interest  
18 admirably as a member of the Joint Federal-State Land Use Planning Commis-  
19 sion; and

20 WHEREAS it is for her untiring devotion to the public good through con-  
21 servation that she was recently elected as president of the Wilderness  
22 Society, a prestigious national conservation organization;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature recognizes Celia  
24 Hunter's long-term commitment to conservation and congratulates her on be-  
25 coming the new president of the Wilderness Society, an honor that she well  
26 deserves.
