3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 NINTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to first aid stations in state
6 buildings.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS state buildings do not presently contain a separate room to
9 serve as a first aid station capable of providing emergency medical care; and

10 WHEREAS the placement of first aid kits in the halls of state buildings
11 has proved to be an inadequate means of providing necessary emergency care;
12 and

13 WHEREAS there have been incidents where individuals remained unconscious
14 and unattended until an ambulance arrived; and

15 WHEREAS the state has a responsibility to safeguard the health of its
16 employees by providing emergency care for employees who are stricken while on
17 the job;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is
19 respectfully requested to instruct the Department of Public Works to provide
20 that in each state building with 20 or more employees there shall be a
21 separate room to be used exclusively as a first aid station capable of
22 providing adequate emergency medical care; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED that all building emergency coordinators and security
24 personnel be made aware of these locations.
