BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS highway safety and safe driving conditions for all users of

9

Alaska's highways are of concern to the legislature;

10

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests

11

the Governor to create a Medical Advisory Commission which is charged with

12

the responsibility of reviewing medical aspects relating to motor vehicle

13

operators' licenses under AS 28.15, and to appoint the following persons to

14

serve on the commission: an ophthalmologist or otolaryngologist, a medical

15

doctor or internist, a psychiatrist, a pathologist, selected from a list of

16

recommendations submitted by the Alaska Medical Association; a professional

17

in the field of alcohol and drug abuse; the commissioners of public safety

18

and health and social services, and the attorney general, or their designees;

and the driver license supervisor of the Department of Public Safety; and be

FURTHER RESOLVED that the commission be directed to report its findings,

22

recommendations, and any proposed legislation to the Governor not later than

23

November 1, 1976; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that on November 1, 1976 the commission is dissolved.
