3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 NINTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Proposing an amendment to art. III of the
6 Constitution of the State of Alaska
7 pertaining to the term of office of the
8 Governor.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Article III, sec. 4 of the Constitution of the State of
11 Alaska is amended to read:

12 SECTION 4. TERM OF OFFICE. The term of office of the governor is
13 six [FOUR] years, beginning at noon on the first Monday in December
14 following his election and ending at noon on the first Monday in December
15 six [FOUR] years later.

16 Sec. 2. Article III, sec. 5 of the Constitution of the State of Alaska
17 is amended to read:

18 SECTION 5. LIMIT ON TENURE. No person who has been elected
19 governor [FOR TWO SUCCESSIVE TERMS] shall be again eligible to hold that
20 office until one full term has intervened.

21 Sec. 3. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed before
22 the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity with
23 art. XIII, sec. 1 of the Constitution of the State of Alaska and the
24 state election laws.
