2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 6

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 NINTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to federal aid for the elimination

6 of ice fog in the Fairbanks area.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS during most of the winter months the Fairbanks area is annually
9 plagued by the phenomenon commonly known as ice fog; and

10 WHEREAS ice fog conditions create extremely hazardous conditions for the
11 people in the area, including but not limited to severe traffic problems, real
12 danger to health, and intolerable risks for children en route to and from
13 school; and

14 WHEREAS the theoretical and applied research requisite for elimination
15 of ice fog is, at this time, beyond the fiscal capability of the state, the
16 North Star Borough, or the city to fund; and

17 WHEREAS Fairbanks has experienced and will continue to experience a
18 massive influx of people and motor vehicles because of the construction of
19 the Alaska pipeline, thus further aggravating what is already a serious
20 problem;

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Congress of the
22 United States is urgently requested to appropriate the required funds so that
23 the necessary theoretical and applied research aimed at the elimination of
24 ice fog can begin at the earliest possible time.

25 COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Gerald R. Ford,
26 President of the United States; the Honorable John L. McClellan, Chairman,
27 Senate Appropriations Committee; the Honorable George H. Mahon, Chairman,
28 House Appropriations Committee; and to the Honorable Ted Stevens and the
29 Honorable Mike Gravel, U.S. Senators, and the Honorable Don Young, U.S.

1 Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
