2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 28

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 NINTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Supporting Comprehensive School Health
6 Education Act legislation.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS there are several bills pending before the United States Congress
9 relating to the Comprehensive School Health Education Act; and

10 WHEREAS each of the various bills would authorize the Commissioner of
11 Education to make grants for teacher training, pilot and demonstration pro-
12 jects, and comprehensive school programs, with respect to health education
13 and health problems; and

14 WHEREAS the provision of a comprehensive program with respect to health
15 education and health problems for the children and youth of the nation should
16 be given high priority; and

17 WHEREAS the grants would be available for health education and health
18 problems such as dental health, disease control, environmental health,
19 family life and human development, human ecology, mental health, nutrition,
20 physical health, safety and accident prevention, smoking and health, sub-
21 stance abuse, consumer health and venereal disease; and

22 WHEREAS passage of such legislation would provide the potential of
23 aiding children and young adults throughout the United States;

24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it urgently requests
25 the United States Congress to take immediate favorable action regarding
26 H.R. 631, H.R. 2599, H.R. 3861 and S. 544.
