5 Relating to child support programs under  
6 P.L. 93-647.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS P.L. 93-647, the Social Service Amendments to the federal social  
9 security Act provides for 50/50 sharing of child support payments recovered  
10 by states from parents of children on aid for families with dependent  
11 children; and

12 WHEREAS the amendments establish a "parent locator service" which is of  
13 doubtful constitutionality; and

14 WHEREAS they provide for the utilization of the Internal Revenue Service  
15 and establish new conditions relative to eligibility to receive aid for  
16 families with dependent children; and

17 WHEREAS the costs of creating this new bureauracy will vastly outweigh  
18 any savings or benefit to the public; and

19 WHEREAS if the program is permitted to continue, it will cost the  
20 Alaskan taxpayers many thousands of dollars;

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it urgently requests  
22 the United States Congress to repeal "Part B - Child Support Programs"  
23 contained in the Social Service Amendments of 1974, P.L. 93-647.
