5 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution
6 of the State of Alaska regarding the dis-
7 qualification of legislators for certain
8 positions.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. Article II, Section 5, Constitution of the State of Alaska,
11 is amended to read:

12 Section 5. DISQUALIFICATIONS. No legislator may hold any other
13 office or position of profit under the United States or the State.
14 [DURING THE TERM FOR WHICH ELECTED AND FOR ONE YEAR THEREAFTER, NO LEGIS-
15 LATOR MAY BE NOMINATED, ELECTED, OR APPOINTED TO ANY OTHER OFFICE OR
16 POSITION OF PROFIT WHICH HAS BEEN CREATED, OR THE SALARY OR EMOLUMENTS
17 OF WHICH HAVE BEEN INCREASED, WHILE HE WAS A MEMBER. THIS SECTION SHALL
18 NOT PREVENT ANY PERSON FROM SEEKING OR HOLDING THE OFFICE OF GOVERNOR,
19 SECRETARY OF STATE, OR MEMBER OF CONGRESS.] This section shall not apply
20 to employment by or election to a constitutional convention.

21 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed before
22 the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity with
23 art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election laws
24 of the state.
