BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. Article II, sec. 8, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is
10 amended to read:

11

SECTION 8. REGULAR SESSIONS. The legislature shall convene each
12 year on the fourth Monday in January, but the month and day may be
13 changed by law. Regular sessions are limited to ninety days. The
14 legislature may extend the session for periods not to exceed twenty
15 days each by a concurrent resolution approved by a two-thirds majority
16 vote of the membership of each house.

* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed
18 before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity
19 with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election
20 laws of the state.
