5 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution
6 of the State of Alaska relating to state
7 aid to private educational institutions.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. Article VII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska,
10 is amended to read:

11 SECTION 1. PUBLIC EDUCATION. The legislature shall by general law
12 establish and maintain a system of public schools open to all children
13 of the State, and may provide for other public educational institutions.
14 Schools and institutions so established shall be free from sectarian
15 control. No money shall be paid from public funds for the direct
16 benefit of any religious or proprietary educational institution or other
17 private preschool, elementary or secondary educational institution.

18 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed
19 before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity
20 with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election
21 laws of the state.
