5 Relating to permit transfer applications
6 under the limited entry law.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

8 WHEREAS the limited entry law (AS 16.43) is under challenge in the
9 courts; and

10 WHEREAS speculation is rapidly increasing the market price of limited
11 entry permits; and

12 WHEREAS many individual hardship cases have been shown to exist in the
13 administration of the limited entry law; and

14 WHEREAS a substantial portion of the fishing population has urged repeal
15 of or a moratorium on the limited entry law; and

16 WHEREAS the legislature is currently considering a bill to repeal the
17 limited entry law and various amendments to it which could impair or annul the
18 market value of a permit;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that it urgently requests
20 the Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission to immediately cease approval of
21 permit transfer applications except for emergency transfers under 20 AAC
22 05.470 or transfers on death of the holder under 20 AAC 05.750.
