5 Relating to permit transfer applications  
6 under the limited entry law.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

8 WHEREAS the limited entry law (AS 16.43) is under challenge in the  
9 courts; and

10 WHEREAS speculation is rapidly increasing the market price of limited  
11 entry permits; and

12 WHEREAS many individual hardship cases have been shown to exist in the  
13 administration of the limited entry law; and

14 WHEREAS a substantial portion of the fishing population has urged repeal  
15 of or a moratorium on the limited entry law; and

16 WHEREAS the Alaska House of Representatives is currently considering  
17 proposed amendments to the limited entry law which could impair or annul the  
18 market value of a permit; and

19 WHEREAS the Alaska House of Representatives is seriously concerned with  
20 the speculative buying and selling of limited entry permits;

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska House of Representatives that it urgently  
22 requests the Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission to immediately cease  
23 approval of permit transfer applications except for emergency transfers under  
24 20 AAC 05.470 or transfers on death of the holder under 20 AAC 05.750.
