6 For an Act entitled: "An Act expressly authorizing dual officeholding by
7 city managers as borough managers; and providing for
8 an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 29.23.130 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

11 (e) A borough adopting a manager plan may, by agreement with a
12 city, enter into a contract providing for the manager of a city located
13 within the borough to serve also as borough manager. A city adopting
14 a manager plan may, by agreement with a borough, enter into a contract
15 providing for the manager of a borough within which the city is located
16 to serve also as city manager. Appointment and service of the manager
17 shall be as otherwise provided for managers in secs. 130 - 150 of this
18 chapter and in AS 29.23.450 - 29.23.470. Nothing in this subsection
19 affects the authority of the assembly or council to provide for other
20 dual officeholding if the dual offices held are compatible or otherwise
21 to appoint officers and employees in accordance with law.

22 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.010.
