6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to legislative interns; and providing
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. INTERNS. During the second regular session of the Ninth
10 State Legislature, the standing committees of each house shall have allotted
11 to them legislative research interns. An intern shall have background or be
12 majoring in a subject area which is related to the substance of the com-
13 mittee's area of concern.

14 * Sec. 2. ALLOCATION OF INTERNS. Each house shall have 11 interns.
15 They shall be assigned as follows: Health, Education and Social Services
16 Committee, two; Finance Committee, two; Resources Committee, two; State
17 Affairs Committee, one; Community and Regional Affairs, one; Judiciary
18 Committee, one; Commerce Committee, one; and Labor and Management Committee,
19 one.

20 * Sec. 3. HIRING. The legislative interns shall be hired by the execu-
21 tive director of the Legislative Affairs Agency and given committee assign-
22 ments by him. However, each intern shall work at the direction of the
23 chairman of the committee to which he is assigned and serve at his pleasure.

24 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 1975.
