6 For an Act entitled: "An Act increasing state aid to municipalities for  
7 fire protection."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 43.18.010(a)(2) is amended to read:

10 (2) \$7.50 [\$5] per capita to cities and boroughs providing  
11 fire protection;

12 (A) fire protection includes, but is not limited to,  
13 fire protection provided by a volunteer fire department registered  
14 with the state fire marshal which has official recognition and  
15 financial support from the city or borough in which it is located;

16 (B) in addition to the grants authorized under this  
17 section, the state shall pay to a volunteer fire department  
18 registered with the state fire marshal and serving an area not in  
19 an organized borough or a city a sum for protection purposes  
20 equal to \$7.50 [\$5] per capita for the population served by the  
21 department, as determined by the state fire marshal using the  
22 latest figures of the United States Bureau of the Census or other  
23 reliable data; grants shall be made on the same basis to facilitate  
24 the organization of volunteer fire departments in an area not in  
25 an organized borough or a city, upon application of the proposed  
26 fire protection group to the state fire marshal and approval of  
27 applications according to standards of organization and service  
28 prescribed by regulations promulgated by the state fire marshal;
