6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the expenditure of state aid to
7 municipalities for fire protection and other purposes;
8 and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 43.18.050 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 43.18.050. SPECIFIC EXPENDITURES. (a) A municipality shall
12 expend funds received for the operation and maintenance of hospitals and
13 health facilities and services under secs. 10 - 99 of this chapter only
14 for those specific facilities and services.

15 (b) A municipality shall expend funds received for fire protection
16 under secs. 10 - 99 of this chapter only for fire protection purposes,
17 unless the municipality is determined and certified by the state fire
18 marshal to have adequate existing fire protection or there are, in the
19 determination of the governing body of the municipality, overriding
20 concerns requiring that the amount received be used for another public
21 purpose.

22 * Sec. 2. AS 43.18.010(f) is amended to read:

23 (f) Funds received by a city, borough or service area under this
24 section may be expended for any public purpose for which it has power
25 to expend public funds, except as provided in (h)(4) of this section
26 and sec. 50 of this chapter.

27 * Sec. 3. AS 43.18.010(h)(4) is amended to read:

28 (4) subject to sec. 50(a) of this chapter, funds received
29 by a local government or hospital outside a municipality under (1), (2)

1 or (3) of this subsection shall be used for expenses of operation or
2 [,] maintenance of hospitals [,] or health services or facilities, as
3 the local government or hospital outside a municipality determines;

4 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 1975.
