6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the sale of alcoholic beverages  
7 on credit."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 04.15.085(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) A [NO HOLDER OF A RETAIL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSE MAY SELL  
11 INTOXICATING BEVERAGES OTHER THAN FOR CASH, PAID PROMPTLY AFTER THE  
12 VERBAL OR WRITTEN SOLICITATION FOR PURCHASE HAS BEEN RECEIVED WITHIN  
13 HIS LICENSED PREMISES EXCEPT THAT A] hotel, boardinghouse or inn which  
14 offers lodging may sell intoxicating beverages to persons lodging there  
15 and include the charge for the beverages with the bill for the lodging,  
16 to be paid at the time the customer pays for the lodging. Other  
17 holders of alcoholic beverage licenses, including but not limited to  
18 retail holders of alcoholic beverage licenses, may sell intoxicating  
19 liquor other than for cash, but only as permitted by regulation  
20 adopted by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board. All other sales  
21 of alcoholic beverages shall be made for cash, paid promptly after  
22 the verbal or written solicitation for purchase has been received  
23 within his licensed premises.
