6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the sale of alcoholic beverages on  
7 credit."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 04.15.085(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) No holder of a retail alcoholic beverage license may sell  
11 intoxicating beverages other than for cash, paid promptly after the  
12 verbal or written solicitation for purchase has been received within his  
13 licensed premises, except that a hotel, boardinghouse or inn which offers  
14 lodging may sell intoxicating beverages to persons lodging there and  
15 include the charge for the beverages with the bill for the lodging, to  
16 be paid at the time the customer pays for the lodging, and except within  
17 a municipality where credit sales have been approved by majority vote of  
18 the voters of the municipality voting on the question a holder of a (1)  
19 beverage dispensary license for a premises which serves meals, (2)  
20 restaurant license, or (3) retail alcoholic beverage license, may sell  
21 intoxicating beverages other than for cash; however, credit extended for  
22 the purchase of intoxicating beverages may not exceed 30 days.
