6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the publication of the names of  
7 juveniles for certain offenses; and changing Rule 26,  
8 Supreme Court Rules of Children's Procedure."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 47.10.090(b) is amended to read:

11 (b) The name or picture of a minor under the jurisdiction of the  
12 court may not be made public [BY A NEWSPAPER, RADIO, OR TELEVISION  
13 STATION] in connection with the minor's status as a delinquent or  
14 dependent child unless [, EXCEPT AS] authorized by order of the court,  
15 except that the name of a minor who is found for the second time to have  
16 violated a law, which if committed by an adult would be a felony, shall  
17 be made public unless the court, for good cause, in certain individual  
18 cases, enters an order prohibiting the disclosure.

19 \* Sec. 2. Section 1 of this Act changes Rule 26 of the Supreme Court Rules  
20 of Children's Procedure in that the rule now provides that the names and  
21 pictures of minors under the jurisdiction of the children's court are not to  
22 be made available to the public unless authorized by a court order which is  
23 accompanied by a written statement supporting the authorization, and sec. 1  
24 provides that for a minor who is found for the second time to have violated a  
25 law, which if committed by an adult would be a felony, the minor's name must  
26 be made public unless the court, for good cause, in certain individual cases,  
27 enters an order prohibiting the disclosure.
