6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to motor vehicle licensing."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 28.10.220 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 28.10.220. VEHICLES USED BY RANCHERS, FARMERS AND DAIRYMEN
10 SUBJECT TO ANNUAL LICENSE TAX. The tax established for private motor
11 vehicles is imposed on each motor vehicle, and trailer, not exceeding
12 an unladen [A] total gross weight of 16,000 [12,000] pounds, owned
13 and operated by a rancher, farmer and dairyman in the transportation
14 of his own ranch, farm, or dairy products from the point of production
15 to market or to the point of transportation to market, or of supplies,
16 commodities, or equipment used on the ranch, farm or dairy. Motor
17 vehicles and trailers licensed under this classification shall be
18 identified as farm vehicles in accordance with regulations prescribed
19 by the department.

20 * Sec. 2. AS 28.10.200(b) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

21 (11) for a vehicle registration by a person who presents
22 written proof, in the form of an affidavit signed by a physician
23 licensed to practice in this state, that he is 70 per cent medically
24 handicapped or that he is disabled to the extent that special considera-
25 tion should be given by the public with respect to the parking or
26 standing in designated spaces of a vehicle which he registers, \$30
27 for one vehicle, and he may receive from the division a special regis-
28 tration plate which displays the standard handicap symbol (the wheelchair
29 logo).
