6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to organizational grants for the
7 transition to borough or city government."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 29.18.180(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) For the purpose of defraying the cost of transition to borough
11 or city government and in order to provide for development and interim
12 governmental operations, each borough and city incorporated after
13 January 1, 1968, or, in the case of a second class city, incorporated or
14 reclassified after January 1, 1968, other than a unified municipality
15 incorporated under the provisions of AS 29.85, or a municipality other-
16 wise incorporated by consolidation, is entitled to an organization grant
17 equal to \$10 for every voter who voted in the borough or city incorpora-
18 tion election. However, each incorporated borough and each first class
19 city incorporated or established by reclassification outside an organized
20 borough is entitled to at least \$75,000 [\$25,000].

21 * Sec. 2. AS 29.18.180 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

22 (d) Each incorporated borough and first class city entitled to an
23 organizational grant under (a) of this section is also entitled to a
24 grant of 75 per cent of the costs incurred for planning, zoning, property
25 tax appraisal and assessment during the first year after incorporation.
