(a) The commissioners of the Department of Public Works and the  
Department of Highways, upon request of the political subdivision or  
village concerned, may first offer and may transfer directly to a  
political subdivision of the state, or [INCLUDING] a village organized  
under Federal Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984), as amended by the Act  
of May 1, 1936 (49 Stat. 1250), [THE TITLE TO] automotive and construc-  
tion equipment which can be used in the maintenance or construction of  
roads and airports, in accordance with this section.

(c) The commissioners, upon request of the political subdivision  
or village concerned, may transfer equipment which in their judgment is  
not economically repairable or is obsolete, without regard to (b) of this  
section.
