6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Public School Foundation
7 Program; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.17.056 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 14.17.056. BASE INSTRUCTIONAL UNIT. The base instructional
11 unit is \$23,250 [\$21,750].

12 * Sec. 2. AS 14.17.051 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

13 Sec. 14.17.051. INSTRUCTIONAL UNIT ALLOTMENT. (a) The instruc-
14 tional unit allotment for each school district is as follows:

15 (1) If the school district is in that part of the state lying
16 within the boundaries of election district 1, 4 or 8, the district shall
17 receive the base instructional unit allotment.

18 (2) If the school district is in that part of the state lying
19 within the boundaries of election district 2, 3 or 7, the district shall
20 receive 103.75 per cent of the base instructional unit allotment.

21 (3) If the school district is in that part of the state lying
22 within the boundaries of election district 5, 9, 10 or 11, the district
23 shall receive 107.50 per cent of the base instructional unit allotment.

24 (4) If the school district is in that part of the state
25 lying within the boundaries of election district 16, south of the Arctic
26 Circle, the district shall receive 111.25 per cent of the base instruc-
27 tional unit allotment.

28 (5) If the school district is in that part of the state lying
29 within the boundaries of election district 6, the district shall receive

1 115 per cent of the base instructional unit allotment.

2 (6) If the school district is in that part of the state
3 lying within the boundaries of election district 12, 13 or 18, the
4 district shall receive 126.25 per cent of the base instructional unit
5 allotment.

6 (7) If the school district is in that part of the state
7 lying within the boundaries of election district 14 or 19, the district
8 shall receive 130 per cent of the base instructional unit allotment.

9 (8) If the school district is in that part of the state lying
10 within the boundaries of election district 15, 16 (north of the Arctic
11 Circle) or 17, the district shall receive 113.75 per cent of the base
12 instructional unit allotment.

13 (b) For the purposes of (a) of this section "election district"
14 means an election district designated in the governor's proclamation of
15 reapportionment and redistricting of December 7, 1961 and retained as to
16 the House of Representatives by the governor's proclamation of
17 September 3, 1965.

18 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1975.
