6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the relationship between the  
7 borough school district and the borough; and providing  
8 for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 14.14.060(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) The borough assembly may by ordinance require that all school  
12 money be deposited in a centralized treasury with all other borough  
13 money. The borough administrator shall have the custody of, invest  
14 and manage all money in the centralized treasury. However,

15 (1) interest on all school money invested by the borough  
16 shall appear in the budget for each fiscal year, and be credited to the  
17 school district, as school district revenue; and

18 (2) the borough assembly, with the consent of the borough  
19 school board, may by ordinance delegate to the borough school board  
20 the responsibility of a centralized treasury.

21 \* Sec. 2. AS 14.14.060(c) is amended to read:

22 (c) The borough school board shall submit the school budget for  
23 the following school year to the borough assembly by April 1 for  
24 approval of the total amount; however, the budget shall be submitted  
25 according to the format for school district budgets prescribed by the  
26 Department of Education. Within 30 days after receipt of the budget  
27 the assembly shall determine the total amount of money to be made  
28 available from local sources for school purposes and shall furnish  
29 the school board with a statement of the sum to be made available.

1 If the assembly does not, within 30 days, furnish the school board  
2 with a statement of the sum to be made available, the amount requested  
3 in the budget is automatically approved. By May 31, the assembly  
4 shall appropriate the amount to be made available from local sources  
5 from money available for the purpose.

6 \* Sec. 3. AS 14.14.060(e) is amended to read:

7 (e) The borough school board is responsible for the design  
8 [CRITERIA] of school buildings, including but not limited to access  
9 roads, utilities, and other auxiliary features related to school ser-  
10 vices and facilities. To the maximum extent consistent with education  
11 needs, a design of a school building shall provide for multiple use  
12 of the building for community purposes. Subject to the approval of  
13 the assembly, the school board shall select and employ the appropriate  
14 professional personnel to develop the designs. The school board shall  
15 submit preliminary and subsequent designs for a school building, includ-  
16 ing but not limited to access roads, utilities, and other auxiliary  
17 features related to school services and facilities, to the assembly  
18 for approval or disapproval; if the design is disapproved, a revised  
19 design shall be prepared and presented to the assembly.

20 \* Sec. 4. AS 14.14.060(f) is amended to read:

21 (f) The borough school board shall provide custodial services  
22 and routine maintenance for school buildings and shall appoint, com-  
23 pensate, and otherwise control personnel for these purposes. The  
24 borough assembly, with the consent of the borough school board, may  
25 by ordinance delegate to the borough administrator the responsibility  
26 for all major rehabilitation, all construction and major repair of  
27 school buildings [THE BOROUGH ASSEMBLY THROUGH THE BOROUGH ADMINIS-  
28 TRATOR, SHALL PROVIDE FOR ALL MAJOR REHABILITATION, ALL CONSTRUCTION  
29 AND MAJOR REPAIR OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS]. However, if that responsibility

is delegated, the [THE] recommendations of the board shall be considered in carrying out the provisions of this section.
