IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
NINTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the transfer of attendance areas
or federal agency schools; and providing for an
effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.20.147 is amended to read:

Sec. 14.20.147. ATTENDANCE AREA TRANSFER, ABSORPTION. When an
attendance area or school operated by a federal agency is transferred
from a currently operating district or from federal agency control or
supervision to, or absorbed into, a new or existing school district
or regional school attendance area, the teachers for the attendance area
or federal agency school also shall be transferred unless otherwise
mutually agreed by the teacher or teachers and the chief school admin-
istrator of the new or existing district or area. Accumulated or earned
benefits, including but not limited to, seniority, salary level, tenure,
leave, and retirement, accompany the teacher who is transferred.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.--
070(c).
