2 SPONSOR SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 130

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 NINTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to grants-in-aid for alcoholic  
7 rehabilitation and prevention."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 47.30.475(c) is amended to read:

10 (c) Grants shall be awarded in a ratio of 90 [75] per cent state  
11 money to 10 [25] per cent community money in communities with a popula-  
12 tion of 2,000 or less [FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING STAFF,] and in the  
13 ratio of 75 per cent state money and 25 per cent community money in  
14 communities with a population of more than 2,000 for the purposes of  
15 providing staff and limited improvement, renovation or new construction  
16 of facilities for alcoholic detoxification, rehabilitation or "half-way  
17 house" care. [NO GRANT FOR IMPROVING, RENOVATING OR CONSTRUCTING MAY  
18 EXCEED \$50,000 EXCEPT WHEN THERE IS A LACK OF APPLICANTS FOR AVAILABLE  
19 MONEY AND THEN ONLY WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE ADVISORY BOARD ON  
20 ALCOHOLISM.] The department is not required to award all money available  
21 under this program, or the full percentages [PERCENTAGE] specified in  
22 this subsection, when another source of money is available or could  
23 reasonably be made available to the applicant.  
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
