6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to grants-in-aid for alcoholic  
7 rehabilitation and prevention."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 47.30.475(c) is amended to read:

10 (c) Grants shall be awarded in a ratio of 75 per cent state money  
11 to 25 per cent community money, except that in communities designated  
12 as poverty areas the ratio shall be 90 per cent state money to 10 per  
13 cent community money, [FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING STAFF, AND IN THE  
14 RATIO OF 75 PER CENT STATE MONEY AND 25 PER CENT COMMUNITY MONEY] for  
15 the purposes of providing staff and limited improvement, renovation or  
16 new construction of facilities for alcoholic detoxification, rehabilita-  
17 tion or "half-way house" care. No grant for improving, renovating or  
18 constructing may exceed \$50,000 except when there is a lack of appli-  
19 cants for available money and then only with the approval of the  
20 Advisory Board on Alcoholism. The department is not required to award  
21 all money available under this program, or the full percentages [PER-  
22 CENTAGE] specified in this subsection, when another source of money is  
23 available or could reasonably be made available to the applicant.

24 \* Sec. 2. AS 47.30.500 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

25 (4) "poverty area" means a district in which 15 per cent or  
26 more of the population, based on the 1970 census data, falls under 125  
27 per cent of the Community Services Administration poverty guidelines.
