6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Governor's Commission on the
7 Administration of Justice."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.19.748 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 44.19.748. MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMISSION. The commission is
11 composed of 13 members, to include the following: the attorney general,
12 the commissioner of public safety, the commissioner of health and social
13 services, the chief justice of the supreme court, the public defender,
14 one member from each house of the legislature, [AND] four other resi-
15 dents of the state chosen by the governor so as to give reasonable
16 geographic and urban-rural balance, including representation from the
17 major ethnic groups of the state, from units of local government and
18 from other groups concerned with the administration of justice in the
19 state, and two other residents of the state representing citizens and
20 professional and community organizations, including those which
21 directly relate to delinquency prevention. Members serve at the
22 pleasure of the governor.

24 Sec. 44.19.754. COMMISSION AS STATE PLANNING AGENCY. The com-
25 mission shall act as the state planning agency under the Federal
26 Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended, and the
27 Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974, as amended.
