6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Governor's Commission on
7 the Administration of Justice."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.19.748 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 44.19.748. MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMISSION. The commission is
11 composed of 13 members, to include the following: the attorney general,
12 the commissioner of public safety, the commissioner of health and
13 social services, the chief justice of the supreme court, the public
14 defender, one member from each house of the legislature, [AND] four
15 other residents of the state chosen by the governor so as to give
16 reasonable geographic and urban-rural balance, including representation
17 from the major ethnic groups of the state, from units of local gover-
18 nment and from other groups concerned with the administration of
19 justice in the state, and two other residents of the state representing
20 citizens and professional and community organizations related to
21 delinquency prevention. Members serve at the pleasure of the governor.

23 Sec. 44.19.754. COMMISSION AS STATE PLANNING AGENCY. The com-
24 mission shall act as the state planning agency under the Federal
25 Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, as amended, and
26 the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974, as amended.
