6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to employees covered by provisions of
7 the Workmen's Compensation Act."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 23.30.230 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 23.30.230. PERSONS NOT COVERED. A person employed as a
11 household or casual worker in or about a private home or household who
12 earns less than \$50 in cash in any three-month period from a single
13 private home or household is not covered by this chapter.

14 * Sec. 2. AS 23.30.240 is amended to read:

15 Sec. 23.30.240. OFFICERS OF CORPORATIONS, MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS,
16 AND NONPROFIT CORPORATIONS AS EMPLOYEES. An executive officer elected
17 or appointed and empowered in accordance with the charter and bylaws of
18 a corporation [, OTHER THAN AN OFFICIAL OF A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OR A
19 CHARITABLE, RELIGIOUS, EDUCATIONAL, OR OTHER NONPROFIT CORPORATION,] is
20 an employee of the corporation under this chapter. [HOWEVER, AN EXECU-
21 TIVE OFFICER OF A CORPORATION MAY WAIVE COVERAGE UNDER THIS CHAPTER,
22 SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE COMMISSIONER OF LABOR, NOTWITHSTANDING
23 SEC. 245(b) OF THIS CHAPTER. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF
24 THIS CHAPTER, AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OR OF
25 A CHARITABLE, RELIGIOUS, EDUCATIONAL, OR OTHER NONPROFIT CORPORATION MAY
26 BE BROUGHT WITHIN THE COVERAGE OF ITS INSURANCE CONTRACT BY THE CORPO-
27 RATION BY SPECIFICALLY INCLUDING HIM IN THE CONTRACT OF INSURANCE. THE
28 ELECTION TO BRING AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER WITHIN THE COVERAGE CONTINUES IN
29 FORCE FOR THE PERIOD THE CONTRACT OF INSURANCE IS IN EFFECT. DURING THAT

1 PERIOD AN EXECUTIVE OFFICER BROUGHT WITHIN THE COVERAGE OF THE INSURANCE
2 CONTRACT IS AN EMPLOYEE OF THE CORPORATION UNDER THIS CHAPTER.]
