6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to limitation of contributions into
7 second injury fund."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 23.30.040(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) If an employee suffers a compensable injury which results in
11 permanent partial disability, the employer or his insurance carrier
12 shall, in addition to the compensation provided for, pay into the second
13 injury fund a lump sum equal to eight per cent of the total compensation
14 to which the employee is entitled for the permanent partial disability,
15 as soon as the total amount of the permanent partial disability payable
16 for the particular injury is determined by the board. If an employee
17 suffers death under this chapter and is at the time of his death un-
18 married, and leaves no children or dependents, the employer is required
19 to pay to the second injury fund the sum of \$10,000 for the sole benefit
20 of those entitled to participation as provided in this chapter. The
21 provision of this subsection shall be waived in and during any calendar
22 year when the unencumbered balance on January 1 in the second injury
23 fund is equal to or exceeds the sum of \$400,000 [\$200,000].
