6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to sound recordings."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 45.51.010 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 45.51.010. REPRODUCTION, SALE WITHOUT CONSENT PROHIBITED.

10 A person who (1) reproduces for sale, sells, offers for sale, or
11 knowingly advertises for sale any [FEDERALLY COPYRIGHTED] sound record-
12 ing that has been reproduced without the written consent of the owner
13 or (2) advertises, offers for sale or resale, or sells or resells a
14 phonograph record, disc, wire, tape, film or other article on which
15 sounds are recorded, without clearly and conspicuously disclosing on
16 the outside cover, box or jacket the actual name and full address of
17 the manufacturer and the name of the actual performer or group, [OF
18 THE MASTER RECORDING] is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction,
19 is punishable by (1) confiscation of the unlawful stock of the re-
20 produced recording and (2) by imprisonment for a period of not more than
21 one year, or by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by both. In this
22 section "owner" means the person who owns the original fixation of sounds
23 embodied in the master phonograph record, master disc, master tape,
24 master film or other device used for reproducing sounds on phonograph
25 records, discs, tapes, films, or other articles upon which sound is
26 recorded, and from which the transferred recorded sounds are directly
27 derived.
