6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to criminal trespass."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 11.20.630 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 11.20.630. TRESPASS. A person other than an officer on
10 lawful business who trespasses on lands or premises in the lawful
11 occupation of another, and fails, neglects, or refuses to depart
12 immediately and remain away until permitted to return upon the verbal,
13 printed or written notice of the owner or person in the lawful occupa-
14 tion of the lands or premises, is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon
15 conviction is punishable by imprisonment for not more than 60 days,
16 or a fine of not more than \$250, or by both [AND SHALL BE COMMITTED,
17 IN DEFAULT OF PAYMENT OF THE FINE AND COSTS IMPOSED, TO ONE DAY FOR
18 EACH \$5 OF THE FINE AND COSTS].
