For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the crime of resisting arrest."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 11.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 11.30.215. RESISTING ARREST. A person who knows or reason-  
ably should know that he is being arrested by a peace officer, and  
who prevents or resists the execution of his own arrest by the use  
of force or by the use of a weapon, is guilty of a misdemeanor and,  
upon conviction, is punishable by a fine of not more than \$500 or  
by imprisonment for not more than 180 days, or by both.
